The Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) role is integral to schools and colleges meeting their legal and statutory obligations related to child safety and welfare.

Whilst the role and its responsibilities are outlined in Keeping Children Safe in Education (KCSiE), there is very little in the way of 'how' to do it.
